

CHILDREN'S COMMITTEE (non-Standing Committee) RIVERCHASE BAPTIST CHURCH

PURPOSE:

To assist the Children's Ministry Director in the planning and execution of church programming for students and families of children ages birth through 5th grade.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Typical responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Planning activities and event for children of all ages
- Transportation as needed to and from events
- Chaperoning during events
- Teaching or group leadership or assisting to secure these
- Building relationships with children and their families
- Assist in fundraising
- Provide prayer and support to children and families

ORGANIZATION:

Members are solicited on an annual basis and are expected to serve at least one year starting in January after commitment is confirmed, or sooner if needed. The number of members is not fixed. The committee members will elect a Chair at the initial meeting in January each year. The Chair will serve as the committee's representative to the Church Council and will attend council meetings upon request.

Participation on the Children's Committee requires a voluntary background check, provided by the church.

MEETINGS:

Meetings are held on a monthly basis, or as needed. An organizational meeting is held at the beginning of the year and a Chair is elected by the committee members during the first meeting.
