

## **MISSIONS COMMITTEE (non-Standing Committee) RIVERCHASE BAPTIST CHURCH**

### **PURPOSE:**

Per the Great Commission to go into the world with the Gospel message, making disciples, baptizing and preaching, the Missions Committee is in charge of planning and promoting mission opportunities for the church membership.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Plans mission activities
- Educates church membership concerning missions
- Leads out in prayer emphases
- Seeks ways to encourage, mobilize and enable participation in going and/or sending others on mission trips and ministries
- Sets goals and promotes special mission offerings

### **ORGANIZATION:**

This committee is made up of those individuals who have a burden for missions and desire to serve the church and our Lord in this manner. Members are solicited on an annual basis and are expected to serve at least one year starting in January after commitment is confirmed, or sooner if needed. The number of members is not fixed, but preference is for 8-12 members of various age groups. Committee chair and officers are elected annually.

The committee members will elect a Chair at the initial meeting in January each year. The Chair will serve as the committee's representative to the Church Council and will attend council meetings upon request.

### **MEETINGS:**

Meetings are held on a monthly basis, or as needed, and are normally held on the second Sunday of each month, immediately following morning worship service.
