

SECURITY COMMITTEE (non-Standing Committee) RIVERCHASE BAPTIST CHURCH

PURPOSE:

The Security Committee provides monitoring and surveillance of the church facilities before, during and after worship services and activities. Its purpose is to ensure church facilities and grounds are a safe environment in which to worship and enjoy fellowship.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Among the actions employed by the committee to help ensure the safety of members and visitors attending events at RBC are:

- Monitor flow of attendees into and out of church building for potential intruders.
- Monitor parking lot and grounds for potential intruders.
- Monitor weather conditions for potential weather threats.
- Take appropriate necessary actions to help ensure the safety of members and visitors, such as:
 - Alert attendees to evacuate building and/or shelter in place.
 - Contact law enforcement if faced with intruders threatening harm.
 - Contact EMTs in the event of a medical emergency.
- Provide radio communication among team members when on duty.
- Be aware of local situations that potentially could have an impact on church activities and take appropriate actions.
- Work closely with ministerial staff, church council, Worship Committee, Congregational Health Committee, Children's Committee, Youth Committee to better meet the needs of the church.

ORGANIZATION:

Members are solicited and selected annually. The number of members is flexible. Members are required to have a background check prior to serving on the committee.

MEETINGS:

Meetings are held throughout the year and on an as needed basis.
