

YOUTH COMMITTEE (non-Standing Committee) RIVERCHASE BAPTIST CHURCH

PURPOSE:

Assist in the planning and execution of church programs for students and families of students in grades 6 through 12.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Typical responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Transportation to and from events
- Chaperone during events
- Occasional teaching or small group leadership
- Attending youth school and community events
- Assist in fundraising
- Provide prayer and support to students and families

ORGANIZATION:

Members are solicited on an annual basis and are expected to serve at least one year starting in January after commitment is confirmed, or sooner if needed. The number of members is not fixed. The committee members will elect a Chair at the initial meeting in January each year. The Chair will serve as the committee's representative to the Church Council and will attend council meetings upon request.

Participation on the Youth Committee requires a voluntary background check, provided by the church.
